

Shawl with squares

The shawl is knitted in one piece with only 2 breaks of the yarn (unless you choose a lot of colorchanges. It is knitted in garter-stitch with approx. needle size 4mm

Knit the modules as numberet in the drawing.

It is important the the yarn end in the corner with the arrow som it can continue without break to the next module. Sometimes it is necessary to knit 59 or 61 rows (instead of the standard 60) to get the yarn to end up in the correct corner.

1st module: Cast on 30 stitches

Knit 1 row

Knit 2 togehter and the rest of the row

Knit 1 row

Knit 2 togehter and the rest of the row

Continue like this until there is only one sticth left

2nd module: Pick up 30 stitches (incl. the loose stitch from the 1st module) from the edge of the 1st module

Knit 60 rows

Place stitches on stitchholder – Except the last stitch wich continues to he 3rd module

3rd module: Pick up 30 stitches (incl. the loose stitch from 2nd module) from the edge of the 2nd module

Knit 1 row

Knit 2 togehter and the rest of the row

Knit 1 row

Knit 2 togehter and the rest of the row

Continue like this until there is only one sticth left

Continue until you have knittede 13 modules – Cut yarn

14th module: Pick up 30 stitches from the edge of the 12th module

Knit 1 row – knit the last stitch together with the 1st stitch from the 10th module stitchholder.

Knit 1 row

Knit 1 row – knit the last stitch together with the 2nd stitch from the 10th module stitchholder.

Knit 1 row

Continue like – keep on knittingg the next stitch from the stitchholder with the last stitch in the row untill you have knittede approx. 60 rows

Put stitches on stitchholder – except for the last stitch which continues to the 15th module.

Continue like this untill you've knitted all the modules (follow the drawing) – Cut yarn

Now knit the framing of the shawl. (Use 4 circular needles... The shawl is big!)

Start at the bottom of the shawl(28th module).

Pick up 210 stitches from the 1st short edge (30 stitches per module)

Pick up 280 stitches from the long edge (40 stitches per module)

Pick up 210 stitches from the 2nd short edge (stitches per module)

Knit 1 row – place stitchmarkers in the 3 corners

Purl 1 row

Knit 1 row– take out 1 sticht on each side of all the stitchmarkes

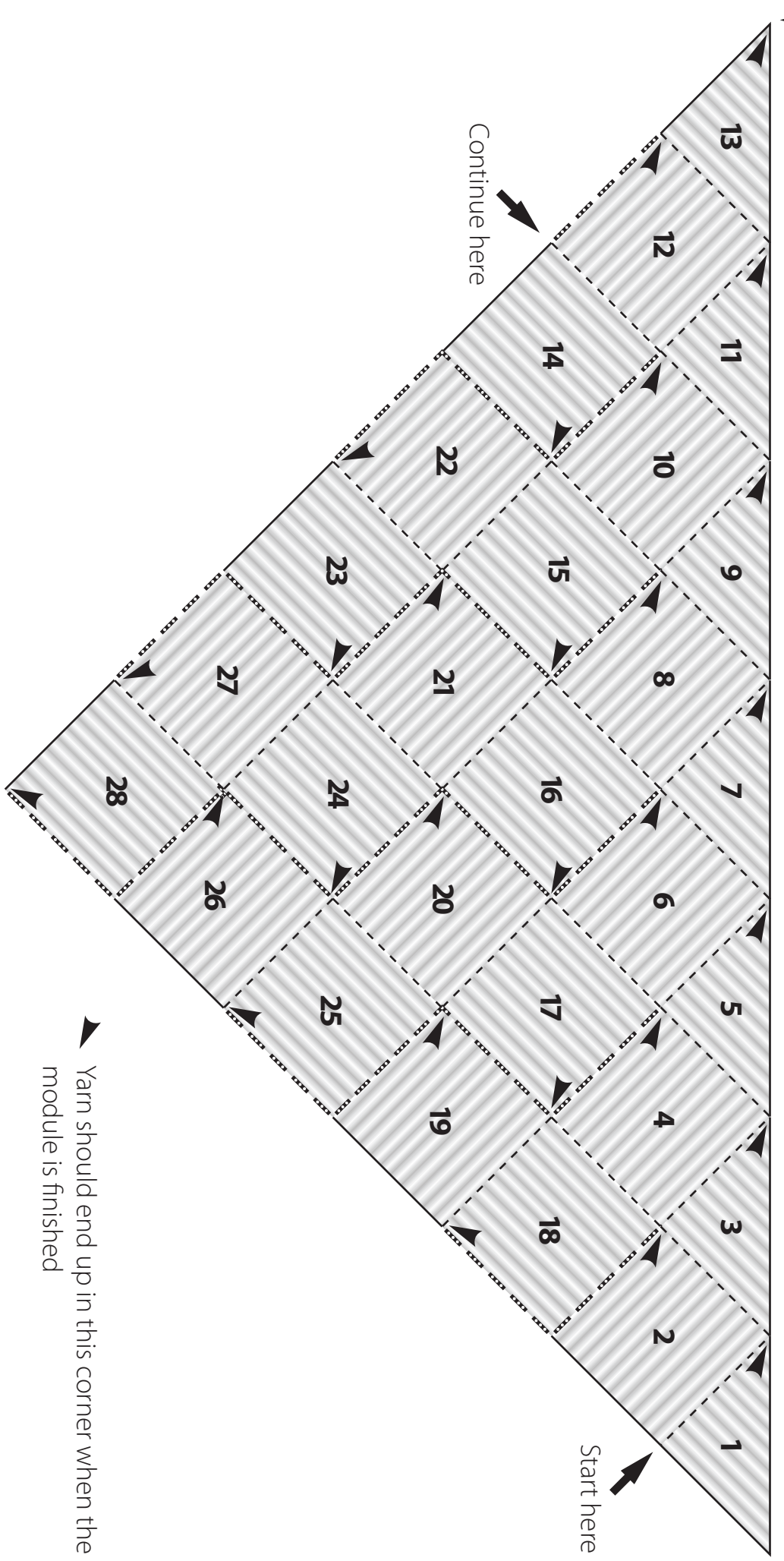
Purl 1 row – take out one stitch on each side of the stitchmarkes the 1st and 13th module

Repeat these to rows untill you have knit 15 row – or until you have the decired frame width.

Cast off very loosely, cut yarn and sow in loose ends.
